AND

Council for Vocational Education and Skill Development having its registered office at No 17/9 Loganathan Nagar, 3rd Street, Choolaimedu, Chennai - 600 094. (Hereinafter referred in short as CVESD) of the Other Part.

Whereas the CVESD has engaged the party of GRT VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE, GRT Mahalakshmi Nagar, Chennai-Tiruttani Highway, Tiruttani, Thituvallur Dt, TamilNadu-631209. who has agreed to affiliate his institute to Council for Vocational Education and Skill Development, for conducting courses as per the list in the Annexure under the category "1.CVCHE - CHILD EDUCATION" 2.CVCOE - COMPUTER EDUCATION" 3.CVYNS - YOGA EDUCATION". and the conditions hereafter contained,

NOW THESE PRESENT WITNESS AS FOLLOWS:

CVESD – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I. General


- a. Trust/society/Individual seeking permission to initiate the CVESD courses in their Institute should apply in the prescribed application form with all the necessary enclosures.
- b. Institute already recognized by CVESD, if applied for renewal, should enclose the copy/ copies of the authorized certificate already obtained from CVESD.
- c. The powers to accept or reject the application for starting a new course/ new Institute shall exclusively rest with CVESD.
- d. CVESD MOU and approval is valid for one year. Approval of the institute should be renewed each year. The renewal fees is Rs.2500/-
- e. The trainees admitted to the course and the institute should follow all the Terms and Conditions prescribed by the CVESD from time to time.
- f. The CVESD has full authority to cancel the Affiliation/Recognition without any prior notice if the affiliated Centre / institute shall be guilty of any deviation or impropriety of any of the CVESD Terms and Conditions.

II Promotion of Programmes

1. The Centre/Institute shall have to take up the responsibility of Promoting the Programmes of CVESD by advertising and publicity. The Centre/Institute shall have to get prior approval of the contents before issue of advertisement/publicity materials through any media, from CVESD
2. The Centre/Institute is restrained from using the name of the Council for Vocational Education and Skill Development and/or logo in any of its documents except stating that the Centre/Institute is the Authorized Collaborative Institution of Council for Vocational Education and Skill Development.

II. Infrastructure and Building

- a. Minimum infrastructure facilities as prescribed by CVESD is essential for conducting CVESD courses. The Institute infrastructure should be enhanced as per the students strength and requirements.
- b. Approval from CVESD is valid for the premises for which the approval is sought. Shifting of the existing premises of the institute should be done only with the consent of the CVESD. Shifting should be made before the commencement of the academic year without affecting the students, it should be obtained from CVESD Chennai. The name of the institution should be suffixed with academy/Institute/Centre/Institution.
- c. The classroom/practical workshop should be at least in the R.C Building/ Building with asbestos roof and it should have adequate space.
- d. Proper and adequate ventilation and lighting should be provided for theory and practical class rooms.
- e. Adequate drinking, water and sanitation facilities should be provided at the institute.
- f. CVESD vigilance committee will inspect the facilities that are made available to the students at the institute, at any time without prior notice.

III. Fees pattern

- a. Fees once remitted to CVESD will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- b. The course fees charged by the institute should be commensurate with the facilities provided to the students. Tuition fees and other charges may be collected on a monthly, quarterly or annual basis.
- c. Registration of students can be made only at CVESD office, Chennai. The registration and examination fee per student is Rs.500/-

IV. Staff pattern

- a. Minimum qualification for teaching staff should be Diploma/ degree/ Masters Degree of the subject Concerned.
- b. Teaching staff must be properly qualified and trained. Detailed bio-data of teaching staff should be sent to CVESD office, Chennai before 30th of August, every year.

V. Curriculum

- a. The Management of the institute after getting the approval from CVESD should conduct classes as per CVESD norms.
- b. The CVESD courses offered in the Institute should be full time courses.
- c. Course name and duration should not be changed by the Institute.
- d. Medium of instruction may be English, Hindi or Mother tongue of the students.
- e. Adequate theory and practical hours should be maintained in the Institute, as per the course curriculum.
- f. If the Institute is not having hospitals, laboratories and other kinds of workshops for imparting practical training to the students, they should make tie-ups with existing hospitals, laboratories and other kinds of workshops and the details of the same should be submitted along with the renewal forms.
- g. CVESD prescribes syllabus for all the courses. This syllabus should be strictly followed and are subject to revision whenever necessary and as desired by CVESD.
- h. A copy of the MOU or Letter of consent for the tie up made should be submitted.

VI. Institution Management

- a. Any advertisement using the Government of India Emblem, giving false information to the public is punishable. It will even lead to the cancellation of the approval of the institute.
- b. No parallel classes/sections shall be conducted in any complex/building other than the premises for which approval was granted.
- c. The Institute should maintain records of attendance of students and teaching staff.
- d. Number of students in one batch should not exceed 50.
- e. Students can be admitted throughout the year for all short term courses
- f. All advertisements or promotional activities must be approved by CVESD Office, Chennai.
- g. Examination will be normally conducted in the Institute where approval was granted. CVESD will nominate the examiners. Examination can be written in any language.
- h. Institutes which run other Certificate, Diploma or Degree courses should not award any certificate merging the same with the CVESD courses conducted in the Institute.

The College is located at Chennai-Tirupathi Highway, GRT Mahalakshmi Nagar, Tiruttani - 631209, Thiruvallur District, Tamil Nadu (www.grtcoe.com).

II. Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University (hereinafter referred to as TNTEU) is an exclusive University for Teachers Education established in 2008, by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No 33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education. The University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society. The TNTEU awards B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. degrees through its Departments as well as through its affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu (<http://www.tnteu.ac.in/>).

III. 4. To establish a global stage for the students and teachers.
5. To strengthen the educational relationships between the TNTEU and GRT College of Education for the welfare of students and teachers.

2. Discretion:

This memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Principal of GRT College of Education.





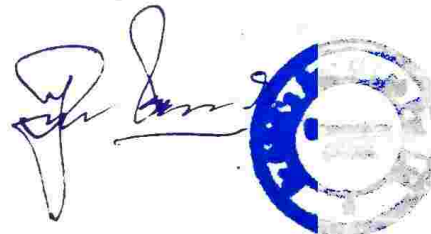

Further, the partners agree to explore possibilities for join collaboration on activities and projects in the mutually interested areas as and when opportunity arises.

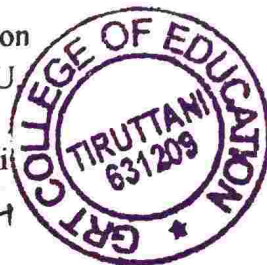

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made at Chennai on this 25th day of July 2022.

BY AND BETWEEN

Sarvam Fintech Private Limited, operating under the brand name **Scholfe**, a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013 and having its registered office at (KOLAB #28, Ground Floor, 16th main, 38th Cross, Jayanagar 4th T Block 560041) (hereinafter referred to as "**Scholfe**", which expression shall unless repugnant to the meaning or context hereof, include its successors and permitted assigns);

AND

GRT College of Education and having its college at Chennai- Tirupathi Highways, Tiruttani 601209, Thiruvallur District, having registration no. _ (hereinafter referred to as "**Institution**", which term shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors, legal representatives and permitted assigns);

Scholfe and the Institution shall hereinafter, wherever the context permits, jointly be referred to as "**Parties**" and individual as "**Party**" and this MOU shall also be referred to as "**Agreement**".

WHEREAS, **Scholfe** is interested in providing financial help for fees/educational loans to parents/students with a view to help parents/students who are in need of the same.

WHEREAS, the Institution has no objection to referring parents/students to Scholfe to render such financial help as it is in the interest of the student community.

WHEREAS, in view of the above, the Parties agree as follows:

- This agreement is on non-exclusive basis and each party is free to engage in similar arrangements without the consent of the other party.
- The Institution will refer its students and/or its parents, who are in need of financial help to Scholfe and the Institution shall not receive any consideration either from Students/Parents or from Scholfe for the same. Scholfe shall have the sole right to approve or decline a loan application to the said parents/students.
- The Institution at all times, shall not be a party to the financial help/arrangement between the student/parent and Scholfe in any manner and accordingly the Institution shall neither be a guarantor in the financial transaction to student/parent/Scholfe nor be liable to repay outstanding sums to Scholfe in the event of a default by the Customer (i.e., parent/student) of Scholfe.
- (i) The Institution shall provide, on demand for each student, the details of fee payable by the student to the Institution, in order to provide the financial assistance of loan by Scholfe to the students/parents.
(ii) In case of Scholfe not disbursing the loan amount directly to the students/parents, the same shall be transferred to the designated bank account of the Institution which shall not exceed the fee amount as provided by the Institution and the same shall be intimated with all details of transfer to the Institution immediately.
- The Scholfe agrees that the Institution will not be held responsible for (i) any actions/defaults by the students/parents in the repayment of the loan money and/or (ii) any grievance or complaint or liability raised by Students/parents against Scholfe under any circumstances whatsoever.
- a. Scholfe represents and warrants that it has all the necessary approvals, permissions etc., under the applicable laws to financial transactions of providing such loans to students/parents and shall at all times comply with all such necessary statutory provisions.
b. These warranties are in addition to all other warranties specified in this Agreement or implied by law, and will survive termination of this Agreement
- Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to create an Agent/Principal relationship and neither party will be entitled to represent the other in any manner.
- The Parties agree that this agreement will be valid for a period of one (1) year and may be extended by mutual written consent every year. Either Party may terminate this agreement without cause by giving 30 day notice period to the other party.

- Brand name, marketing collaterals and logos of both the Parties form part of their intangible assets and therefore must not be used without written authorization from the other Party. Nothing in this Agreement is to be construed as an assignment, transfer or grant of right to use of any intellectual property except as specifically stated in this Agreement.
- In the event of any breach of the provisions of this Agreement or misrepresentation of any covenant, warranty or representation made by the Scholfe under or pursuant to this Agreement, the Scholfe shall indemnify the Institution, its members of governing body, its respective officers, directors, employees, agents, group companies and affiliates (together the "Representatives") and hold Institution and its Representatives harmless from any and all loss, damage, liability and expense (including reasonable legal fees and costs) sustained or incurred by the Institute and its Representatives brought about by anybody on the Institution, as a result of or in connection with such breach or misrepresentation. It is hereby clarified that the rights of the Institution and its Representatives under this Clause shall be in addition to the rights and remedies available to Institution and its Representatives under this Agreement or under applicable laws
- Any dispute in relation to this MOU shall be resolved by arbitration at Chennai, before a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. The arbitration shall be in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or amendments thereto and shall be conducted in English.
